### **Embassy News**

2024 has begun with the UK and US as close allies as ever, standing shoulder to shoulder in the face of global crises. These past few months have proven a testament to our shared values, as we remain in lockstep with the US and our allies to respond to the current situation in Israel and Gaza.

Foreign Secretary Lord Cameron, visited Washington in December of 2023 in his first visit in this role

as we look ahead to continuing the UK's long-standing commitment to Ukraine.

Over the last year, 76 UK ministers have travelled coast to coast across the United States, cementing our deep ties at the federal, state and local level across all manner of industries, communities and sectors.

2024 begins with our robust economic and trade relationship continuing to flourish with over \$1 trillion invested

in one another's countries, 2.7 million jobs created and trade worth \$350 billion a year. Lord Johnson, the UK's Minister for Investment in the Department of Business and Trade visited DC, Miami and New York in January of 2024 and engaged with BABA members at dinner to further strengthen the close UK-US business partnership.

In November, the Prime Minister hosted the first ever global AI Safety Summit at Bletchley Park, bringing together key countries, technology organisations, academia and civil society to convene on the safe development of frontier AI technology. Vice President Harris and Commerce Secretary Raimondo attended from the US side. 28 attending countries signed the historic Bletchley Agreement, a world first agreement on the need for international collaboration on frontier AI safety.

In November, Business and Trade Secretary Kemi Badenoch and Florida Governor Ron DeSantis signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to boost trade and investment between the UK and Florida. Florida has a GDP of nearly \$1.5 trillion— the fourth biggest of any US state and roughly the same size as Spain. This marks the seventh MoU the UK has signed with

an individual US state--including- Indiana, North Carolina, South Carolina, Oklahoma, Utah, Washington, and Florida – with a combined GDP of \$4.1tn. The UK is also actively engaging with further states including Texas, California, Colorado, and Illinois.

UK Secretary of State for Transport joined Virgin Atlantic CEO Shai Weiss and Founder Sir Richard Branson on the world's first 100% sustainable aviation fuel

transatlantic flight by a commercial airline, made possible by £1 million of UK government funding. This flight flew from London Heathrow to New York's JFK airport—marking a crucial step in the UK's journey to jet zero aviation by 2050.

In November, the Prime Minister convened world leading investors and CEOs

for the Global Investment Summit to unveil \$36.8 billion of private sector investment across tech, energy, manufacturing and life sciences.

As part of the Prime Minister's Global Investment Summit, Microsoft committed \$3.2 billion as an investment in the UK's critical AI infrastructure. In January of 2024, Google announced a \$1 billion investment in the UK in a new UK data centre, marking a vote of confidence in the UK's world leading tech sector.

In the DC community in December, British Ambassador to the US Dame Karen Pierce joined Mayor Muriel Bowser to read Paddington Bear to a group of kindergarten through second grade students at Dorothy Height Elementary School. To celebrate Paddington's 65th anniversary in 2023, the Embassy gifted 2,500 Paddington books to Title One DC Public Schools as part of our collaboration with DC Public Schools and HarperCollins to promote early childhood literacy and Paddington's much beloved themes of kindness across different cultures.

The Embassy looks ahead to another year of UK-US economic innovation through our collaboration with BABA to foster business growth and partnership on both sides of the Atlantic.



# Womble Bond Dickinson Attorneys Quoted In Legaltech News Regarding 2023 Cybersecurity and Data Privacy Milestones

Womble Bond Dickinson attorneys Ted Claypoole and Tara Cho were quoted in Legaltech News discussing the biggest developments in data privacy and cybersecurity during 2023.

Ted Claypoole commented that "2023 saw a return to simple fraud and brazen extortion from cybercriminals as instances of man-in-the-middle attacks and false invoice presentation exploded and one ransomware group actually filed a complaint with the SEC to force its victim to pay. The Black Cat/ALPHV ransomware group filed an SEC complaint under new reporting rules alleging that one of their victims failed to disclose a cyberattack to the SEC within the required four days. This was likely not what the SEC anticipated by requiring public companies to report cyberattacks."

## Lockheed Martin Awarded Contract For 18 Space Development Agency Tranche 2 Satellites

The Space Development Agency (SDA) has awarded Lockheed Martin (NYSE: LMT) a contract to build 18 space vehicles as part of its Tranche 2 Tracking Layer constellation.



Lockheed Martin will provide 16 wide field of view missile warning/missile tracking space vehicles with infrared sensors and two space vehicles with missile defense infrared sensors that can generate fire control-quality tracks to provide preliminary missile defense mission capabilities. This firm-fixed price, other transaction agreement has a total potential value of \$890 million.

The T2 Tracking Layer will accelerate the capability to provide global, persistent indications, detection, warning, tracking, and identification of conventional and advanced missile threats, including hypersonic missile systems. It will also deliver preliminary missile defense capability by incorporating fire control quality sensors in the constellation.
